Dear Sir/Madam,

Further to Greg Klein's January 4th letter entitled "Province needs to stand up to the entrenched interests", we would like to clarify the work of the Special Committee to Inquire into the Use of Conducted Energy Weapons and to Audit Selected Police Complaints.

In the fall, the Committee invited public input by issuing a call for submissions and held public meetings with invited expert witnesses as well as groups/individuals that had requested to appear on October 9th, 15th, 16th, 22nd, November 19th, 26th, and December 3rd and 10th. The transcripts of the meetings are publicly available on the Committee's website.

The Committee was tasked with conducting an audit respecting the outcome or resolution of randomly selected complaints and investigations under Part 1 of the Police Act and engaged the services of the Office of the Auditor General. The Auditor General submitted and publicly presented his report to the Committee on December 3rd.
